The House of Manasseh and Ephraim is an 18-month program designed to assist men with any type mind of mood altering substances. The objective is to be an outreach to men that are constrained by substance abuse issues. The goal of the program is to assist in the recovery and transition of men from a lifestyle of chemical substance abuse to a lifestyle conducive to being a disciplined and productive citizen in society.
